As we monitor recent measles activity in Virginia, we want to reassure you that we are taking active steps to keep our patients, families, and staff safe.

Over the coming weeks, you may notice additional screening questions when scheduling or arriving for appointments. These questions help us manage potential exposures and ensure safe care for everyone in our offices.

To maintain a safe environment:

- Patients with fever will be screened before entering the office.
- For walk-in visits involving fever or illness symptoms, please call the office upon arrival before entering the building.
- If there are concerns regarding vaccination status or possible exposure, a charge nurse or provider may call you before the visit begins. Depending on the circumstances, care may be provided in your vehicle or inside the office using specific precautions.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we implement these measures to protect infants, immunocompromised patients, and other vulnerable members of our community.
